

ALL STUDENTS - OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAYS

Though infrequent, when they occur, students are asked to adhere to the following directives: Students should be dressed modestly. Clothing should neither be form-fitting nor too loose. From October 16 – April 30 shorts may not be worn on out-of-uniform days.

Skirts / shorts must be worn at knee length.

No midriffs should show.

No spaghetti straps; shoulders should be covered.

Avoid “trendy” and “statement-style” clothing (i.e., gothic, punk etc.), including hair, make-up, jewelry and shoes.

Any messages on t-shirts, etc. must be appropriate.

Shoes must have a back.

Uniform jewelry rules apply.

One’s appearance should not be a distraction to others.
