GUIDELINES FOR PRESCRIBING MEDICATIONS TO BE ADMINISTERED TO STUDENTS DURING THE SCHOOL DAY

- 1. Whenever possible, avoid prescribing medication for administration during school hours.
- 2. Schools are required to have appropriately labeled pharmacy containers. These are kept locked in the school clinic.
- 3. Any change of prescription requires new written orders from prescriber.
- 4. Carrying of inhalers is discouraged for young children, because they are easily lost or forgotten at home, leaving the student without medication. Middle school students participating in after school activities, may carry if they have physician and parent permission.
